CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

On arrival at the Pukekohe Park Raceway all entrants will be required to present their driver's licences to the Event Secretary located in the Timing Building, for checking. All drivers and passengers must sign the User Agreement form and attend the drivers' briefing before the start of the event. All vehicles will need to have their registrations and Warrants of Fitness checked by an Event Official before being allowed onto the track.

(1) DRIVER AND VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

- All vehicles participating in this event MUST have a current Warrant of Fitness and Registration, or MSNZ logbook relevant to the vehicle
- All drivers MUST have a current civil driver's licence
- All drivers and passengers MUST sign a User Agreement (Indemnity) Form before entering the circuit
- All vehicles MUST be fitted with an effective muffler that prevents the vehicle from exceeding a noise level of 95dBA (sound monitoring equipment will be in use around the circuit throughout the event)
- All participants, whether driver or passenger or other, MUST comply with any instructions, directions or requests given by the Circuit Manager or his representative

(2) SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- It is compulsory for all drivers and passengers to wear covered shoes, long-sleeved clothing (no shorts or tee-shirts allowed), helmet and neck brace as a minimum standard (approved race suits or 100% cotton overalls, gloves and other safety apparel are optional). Helmets and neck braces will be available for hire at the track on the day of the event for any driver or passenger that does not have them
- Seat belts MUST be worn by the occupants of all vehicles while on the circuit
- All participants must exercise due care at all times and not act in a reckless or dangerous manner
- An ambulance and fire extinguishers will be on site as part of the Circuit and Facilities Hire Agreement

(3) GENERAL RULES

- Adults must keep control of children in their care
- Dogs and other animals are not permitted within Pukekohe Park
- No alcohol or drugs are to be consumed by drivers or passengers during the event
- Security of personal property is the responsibility of the individual any suspicious person or activity should be reported to the Circuit Manager or a member of the Organising Club
- The facilities must be left in a tidy condition all rubbish is to be deposited in the receptacles provided
- No entry is allowed to any part of the circuit or its facilities that have not been included in the hire agreement
- No property belonging to Pukekohe Park is to be removed or interfered with in any way that may result in loss or damage
- The timing building and toilet block in the pits will be available to use during the event
- Gates will be open at 8.00am and the track available for use from 9.00am. Track activities will be concluded by 4.30pm

PLEASE NOTE:

This Play Day has been organised as a fun event for the members of invited car clubs who would like an opportunity to drive their cars at speed in a safe and controlled environment, without having to worry about speed cameras, highway patrol vehicles and on-coming traffic. It is also a chance for the members of different car clubs to participate in an activity together, and to share their friendships and passions.

The utmost importance on driver and vehicle safety will be accentuated during the running of this event. We do not want to see anyone injured or any vehicles damaged as a result of reckless or dangerous behaviour by any participant. As such, it is the responsibility of every driver to ensure they drive within their own capabilities and the stability and performance limits of the vehicles they are driving, at all times.

REMEMBER – This is a track play day, NOT a race!
